EQUIPPING

Four Corners Global is a conduit for many speakers and events to train pastors, leaders and believers. Training is essential to see leaders growing deeper with God and passing it on to their churches. Leaders who carry an anointing to train the body of Christ are necessary.

BUILDING UP THE BODY

Four Corners Global believes that the church of Belgium needs to be strong to withstand the onslaught of humanism, Islam and atheism that bombards us every day. We encourage understanding of Biblical foundations and strengthen believers through discipleship.

UNITY of FAITH

Four Corners Global is bridge building ministry for Belgium. By working with various groups, denominations and languages, we facilitate the strengths of one group to carry over to another group. Unity is necessary to reach the nation. When we work together, we are stronger and reflect God better.



Our ANET churches hosted Bishop Tony Miller. Our faith was elevated. Often, we realize what a battle that we face. Our discouragement robs us of living with the shield of faith. Holy Spirit restored us as Tony spoke.

We initiated the recording of 11 programs with French CBN 700 Club. This production will go across the French-speaking world – 120 channels. The series examines why God cares about Israel. The CBN studio is located in our office building and affords us a unique opportunity to reach French-speakers.



HarvestNet is an USA born group which has turned global. Their desire to establish ministry relationships in Europe is a welcomed and refreshing fountain for us. They are based on the presence of God and the 5-fold ministry of Ephesians 4:11. In March HarvestNet hosted a conference in London, England for the purpose of unifying ministries between countries from Ireland to Ukraine. Belgium had 5 representatives, including Rocky, at this inaugural training event.



Months of training with our core group culminated in going to a local church and boosting their passion for prayer and evangelism. Our team gave one week of training to this group and took them out on the street to reach their neighborhood. We have since returned to do evangelism with them again.



Rocky has become the webmaster for a new website: *Pourquoi Israel.org* We have launched this site to educate French speakers about the Jewish issues in the news. This information is vital since the French news is heavily against Israel.

Since the number of Bible believing churches is such a minority in Europe, it is encouraging and vital for us to get together to form connections and strategies.



Our discipleship group is growing stronger and strengthening the churches they attend. We have a list of 100 names of contacts for return visits and ministry.

On Resurrection Sunday, Rocky preached at this Congolese Church and it was packed full. The Lord anointed me to make salvation clear and to empower their progress in walking with God. 7 people responded as first time salvations and that is great news!



This man works for the Israeli embassy and his job is to make relationships with non-Jews with the goal of fostering good relations. This is the kind of unity we pray for that we can experience this verse: “that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace, and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity.” – Ephesians 2:16
