Organizing the conference was one part, but meeting with Pastors and stirring their hearts to rally together and participate was a 6-month effort. It allowed me to meet one on one with many leaders and allowed me to talk about key issues that are holding back the church from growing. I was most excited that I got the chance to pray and plant Godly seeds all over Belgium and Europe.

Muslim extremists have set up a base of operations in one part of the city and they are scheming and recruiting segments of the society. People around the world now know the name Molenbeek. For 20 years Arabs have been pouring into these neighborhoods and the Belgians have been leaving. A few years ago, they had a mayor who relaxed the laws to be more favorable for Muslims. Shariaforbelgium spoke from that place as they hurled threats toward the natives.

All that is going on in the natural realm but we know that the real battle is a spiritual one. During the first shut down of the city of Brussels, the police were searching for Abdeslam in this city. He retreated from the Paris attacks and there was a threat that he would do a suicide bombing. We were invited to this district of the city to minister. Rickey Augustus gave his testimony and it was a homerun. The people stayed for 9 to have Rickey and I pray for them. (They really wanted Rickey to pray) We had 4 instantaneous healings and many answers to prayer. It was unusual for the people to wait 9 hours. They sensed something special. Even the pastor wanted his turn at the end.

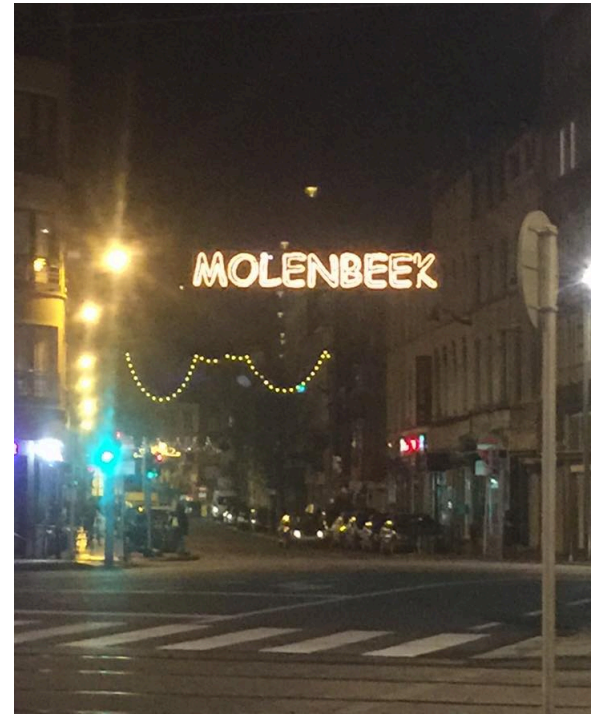
All this makes Molenbeek a perfect target for your prayers. Please pray for this district and for the Belgian church as we clash with the spiritual forces operating there.
